No-Knuckling Training Socks

The No-Knuckling Training sock is a rehabilitation tool designed to enhance proprioception in patients with neurological deficits. It is designed for short term use multiple times daily to help correct the gait and improve paw placement. The sensory stimulation acts as a reminder for pets to lift their limb higher during gait training.

- Encourage patients with dragging paws to improve paw placement
- Incorporate to enhance your rehabilitative training sessions
- Great for rehab use after spinal surgery or for pets suffering from disc disease.
